A dance artist and a dance teacher. I graduated as a dance artist in 2012, then in 2015 I qualified as a dance teacher at the Budapest College of Contemporary Dances. I had the opportunity to learn from recognized contemporary dancers and choreographers, such as Peter Jasko, Anton Lacky, Taka Shamato, in workshops both at home and abroad. I attended, among others, the Brussels P.A.R.T.S. dance school, ImpulseTanz in Vienna and the courses of Deltebre Dansa. As a dance artist I worked for the Modern Dance Arial Company, Madrid and had roles in inner city and rural theatres, in the dance scenes of films and in dance films. I could work with distinguished choreographers, e.g. Viktória Jaross, Klári Pataky, Péter Gemza.

My experience as a dancer has inspired my teacher's career as well: dance techniques and the playfulness of creativity merge at my lessons. At present I teach at the Budapest Dance School and the drama section of the Kodály School at the culture centre of 'Marczibányi Square', Budapest. I recommend creative dance and modern dance to children and teenagers who would like to learn forms of movement which give them confidence in everyday life, develop their body- and self-awareness.
