**Date:** November 3rd and 4th, 2023

**The topics of the conference**, as proposed by the Program Committee, are the results of research in the aesthetic, historical, and educational fields of dance from a theoretical, methodological, or practical approach. The main disciplinary areas of the conference are dance history, aesthetics, kinetography, pedagogy, and psychology.

**Languages:** English and Hungarian

### Participation

There is no registration fee for the conference. After the closing of the reviewing process, acceptance/rejection letters are sent until 15 October 2023.

### Type of proposal

- Section presentation (15 min presentation + 5 min discussion)
- Thematic panels (60 min presentation + 20 min discussion)
- Interactive workshops (45 – 60 min)

The keynote speakers will be invited by the Program Committee.

A thematic panel incorporates at least three speakers (including the panel moderator) and at least one opponent on a closely related topic. A panel participant may also apply to a session presentation.

**Abstracts** (n: 1000-1500 characters) should include (1) the title; (2) the name(s) of the presenter(s) or contributor(s); (3) 3-5 keywords, and (4) the description of the topic, its novelty, the research methods, and the main results. The abstract should not include references or a bibliography.

A Hungarian-English bilingual volume of the submitted abstracts will be published and handed out to participants at the conference's opening.

In the case of a panel proposal, the application form should be given in only by the panel leader, indicating the names of the other contributors.

**Deadline** for applications: **15 June 2023**.
