



CEEPUS MOBILITY IN AST /BYTOM : summer semester 2025/2026

1. Long-term Mobility (one semester)



Period: March 4 – June 19, 2026



Minimum duration: 3 months and 15 days

Description:

This is an intensive program dedicated to students interested in long-term artistic and research work. Participants will have the opportunity to complete a selected part of curriculum of the Dance Theatre Actor specialization.

The study program includes:

- Contemporary dance techniques and physical dance,
- Polish folklore and traditional dance,
- Acting classes,
- Inspirations and Creative Innovation Lab – a space for interdisciplinary artistic workshops and individual creative development that will be supported by a mentor from our faculty.

Opportunities for incoming students:

- Completing a significant part of study program of Dance Theatre Actor specialization,
- Artistic workshops in various contemporary dance techniques,
- Developing individual creative projects,
- Taking part in classes and educational events.

Conditions:

- each mobility student receives a scholarship of PLN 2,500 (approximately EUR 590) per month for accommodation and maintenance. This mobility covers 4 months scholarship.
- no dormitory in AST, but we can support students in accommodation searching.

2. Short-term Mobility – Session I



Period: March 9 – March 30, 2026 (21 days)



Minimum duration: 3 weeks

Description:

The influence of folk art and tradition on shaping the Contemporary Dance and Performing Arts. The main goal is to encourage collaborative work process between students from partner institutions, developing both technical and artistic skills.

Activities:

- Interdisciplinary workshops with artists and academic teachers,
- Intensive creative work in international students group,
- Joint artistic research,
- Presentation of the final work on World Theatre Day, at the Śląsk Song and Dance Ensemble in Koszęcin.

Conditions:

- each mobility student receives a scholarship of PLN 2,500 (approximately EUR 590) per month for accommodation and maintenance. This mobility covers 1 month scholarship.
- no dormitory in AST, but we can support students in accommodation searching.



3. Short-term Mobility – Session II

 Period: April 9 – April 30, 2026 (21 days)

 Minimum duration: 3 weeks

Description:

The artistic process resulting from anthropological findings. Field research as an inspiration for creative exploration in the area of dance theater / bodily expression

Activities:

- Interdisciplinary workshops with artists and academic teachers,
- Intensive creative work in international students group,
- Joint artistic research,
- participation in field research,
- demonstration of creative work during the International Dance Day

Conditions:

- each mobility student receives a scholarship of PLN 2,500 (approximately EUR 590) per month for accommodation and maintenance. This mobility covers 1 month scholarship.
- no dormitory in AST, but we can support students in accommodation searching.
